III. WRITTEN & VERBAL REPORTS: See attached written reports.

A. A. Capraro (NRCS):

- EQIP–RCPP-Delaware River working with the Pinchot Institute and common waters. FY17 has five sign-ups for the forestry program. Contracts are written and in the process of being signed. FY18 has five applications for forestry resources and three applications already signed for streambank restoration and buffers. Deadline for sign-up is July 21st.
- EQIP-General Nine current applications. Will work with landowners through the summer to create a plan for application submission in the fall.
- EQIP-RCPP Young Forest Initiative Has no sign-ups at this time.
- CRP Grasslands One contract signed up with FSA. Planning is done and contract signed with FSA.
- CSP One preapproved application for forestry.

IV. <u>OLD BUSINESS</u>:

- A. Neversink/Rondout Grant: See written report
 - Working on three large bank stabilization projects in Claryville. Rondout, Sundown and Moll's Brook. Denning Town Hall and Moll's Brook may be ready to start this fall.
 - Have sought two additional proposals for engineering work due to present selected firms have been unable to meet our needs in a timely manner: Wetland Studies from Virginia; and Stantec, who has a satellite office in Rosendale.

B. District Policies:

- Currently working on updating all policies. Will present policies to board as they are completed.
- New policies being created are an Internship Policy and a FOIL Policy.

C. Program Updates:

- The Jeff school flood mitigation expenses will be through the county flood mitigation and Part C funds.
- The No-Till seeder has been working after being repaired. No invoice or bill has been received from the Truax Company.
- Bass & Minnow program was a success. Approximately 40 people ordered fish and the pickup date was Saturday, June 24th.
