- B. Flood Mitigation:
 - NRCS Cattail Brook Project; bids were rejected on the project and it will be rebid in the spring. Brian will speak with Tony C. to make sure funding will not be lost for this
 - Sandburg Creek stream problem for next year's flood mitigation; Soil and Water will meet with DPW personnel to review damages at the location and determine what can be done to mitigate
- C. CCE Lease Agreement:
 - After some discussion, Robert Kaplan proposed to make a utilities and maintenance agreement for same amount we pay now
 - Board discussed possibility of recouping some of the utilities and maintenance monies from USDA for providing space at our office for them to conduct business; we will examine the MOA with NRCS to see if this is a possibility
- D. Ag & Markets:
 - Check on Ag and Markets grant for farms released 10/12/15
 - A brief discussion was held on the 2016 Part B Conservation Project money, and Gene B. made a motion to submit the Conservation Project Financial Assistance agreement for the Route 97 bridge in Hankins. Robert K. seconded the motion and it was passed and carried.
